## Guidelines for Diploma Program for Working Professionals in AICTE Approved Institutions

AICTE Approved Institutes are eligible to run Diploma Program/Courses from the A/Y 2023-24 for working Professionals ONLY in the approved disciplines/courses Maximum THREE Courses per Institute is permitted with an approved intake of 30 in each course. Core disciplines with specialization in upcoming technologies will be given preference. As per the Provisions of the Public Notice issued by AICTE vide No. AICTE/RB/Academic/2023-24 dated 16th August, 2023 following guidelines are applicable to run the courses.
